Workpackages

WP4: Nudging and self-nudging toolkits

Trendhuis started working on WP4 and has developed a roadmap for creating nudges.

The University of Barcelona suggested adding a comprehensive section on ethics rather than just a small partition. ACEEU will send a checklist for the ethical council which we can integrate in the roadmap.

ACEEU asked to breakdown the section of creating the nudges and add more steps. They also will send a document about the creating of the nudge.

The University of Barcelona raised concerns regarding differences in platform usage, guidelines, and restrictions among countries. For instance, American students were prohibited from utilizing AI, risking expulsion from the university if they did so. These variations posed challenges to student collaboration.

We discussed framing this example primarily as a policy issue. To address it, we propose integrating a dedicated session into a separate segment of the roadmap focusing on policy considerations and the involvement of stakeholders at various levels.

ACEEU will send the checklist for the ethical council and the document about the creating of the nudges to Trendhuis. Thorsten and Almaz will continue the work of Adisa, who will be leaving ACEEU soon.

Trendhuis will adjust the roadmap integrating a section about the ethical considerations, an others about policy and stakeholder levels. Moreover they will add more detailed steps to the creating of the nudges based on the document send by ACEEU.

WP5: Video training for HEI Administrators and Mooc for self-Nudging HE educators

Momentum talked about their vision for WP5 and expressed the intention to present a more detailed proposal during our in-person meeting in Italy this October. They can make a template and a guide on how to present the video's.

They suggested recording ourselves during our next meeting in Camerino. It is important that we make the videos and the MOOCS attractive and visual.

WP4: Nudging and self-nudging examples

Barcelona brought up an example of informational nudges for educators that did not have the expected result. It seems that nudges for students are more frequently implemented than nudges for educators.

Trendhuis pointed out that we need to design the nudges ourselves. We can use the examples to learn from. Visual examples engage the audience on a deeper level through imagery and illustrations.
